Solution Impact

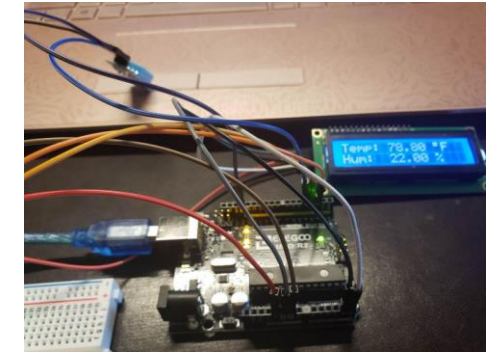
