Energy Innovators Scholars

Energy Innovators Fellows

College-level participants will participate in the **Fellows Track**. This would provide access to comprehensive experiential learning in hard, soft and professional development skills useful to the clean energy and offshore wind industries in addition to an Energy Innovators research project and mentor.
