This coalition aims to support multifamily affordable housing providers by strengthening their solar and battery development capacity through **workforce development** for disadvantaged communities in Carson, LA county. We will also design a **virtual power plant (VPP) strategy** to enable multifamily aggregation of solar+batteries, decarbonizing grid services, offering equity and sustainability.

Key Aims

Multifamily housing providers are uniquely positioned to benefit from the combination of solar and storage systems. Providers, however, often do not have the technical expertise and face capacity constraints.

A two-pronged solution of: (i) new training program in the benefits of battery storage & solar for multifamily use cases to boost expertise & technical knowledge in multifamily affordable housing providers, and (ii) VPP strategy to accelerate adoption and benefits of clean energy.

To contribute towards increased adoption of solar & battery storage in disadvantaged multifamily segments, by providing clean energy workforce development opportunities while executing on a VPP strategy to decrease energy burden, environmental exposure & cost of capital by financing DERs at scale.
