

SC Energy Justice Coalition

A robust and diverse coalition of over 50 organizations working to support communities dealing with high energy burdens and other inequities in the SC energy system.

Membership of the coalition spans geographic racial and economic lines with representation from disadvantaged communities including: Black, Spanish-speaking, Native American, Asian communities and more.

Large portions of the state have AVERAGE energy burdens exceeding 6% - a generally recognized limit for affordability.

Goal: Reduce energy burdens for SC communities with emphasis on disadvantaged communities or DACs
