



How it works

- 1) Transition Energy installs solar energy systems on household rooftops at no cost to homeowner ("host").
- 2) Households, small businesses, and other organizations in the local community subscribe to a portion of the energy generated from a particular system in the area.
- 3) Subscribers receive solar energy credits that will offset their monthly utility bill, resulting in a lower cost of electricity.



"Subscribers"

How the Community benefits

- ✓ **Savings:** 25% lower price than the utility, guaranteed. Average savings per subscriber expected to be \$750 in first year.
- ✓ **Equity ownership:** Community members have the option to own the solar energy systems.
- ✓ **Job creation:** Local contractors are needed to maintain many systems for their 30-year operating lifespan.
- ✓ **Electrical grid resilience:** Battery compatibility improves self-sufficiency and strengthens local grid.
- ✓ **Improved health:** Clean solar energy replaces fossil fuel emissions, which may alleviate asthma and other health issues.
