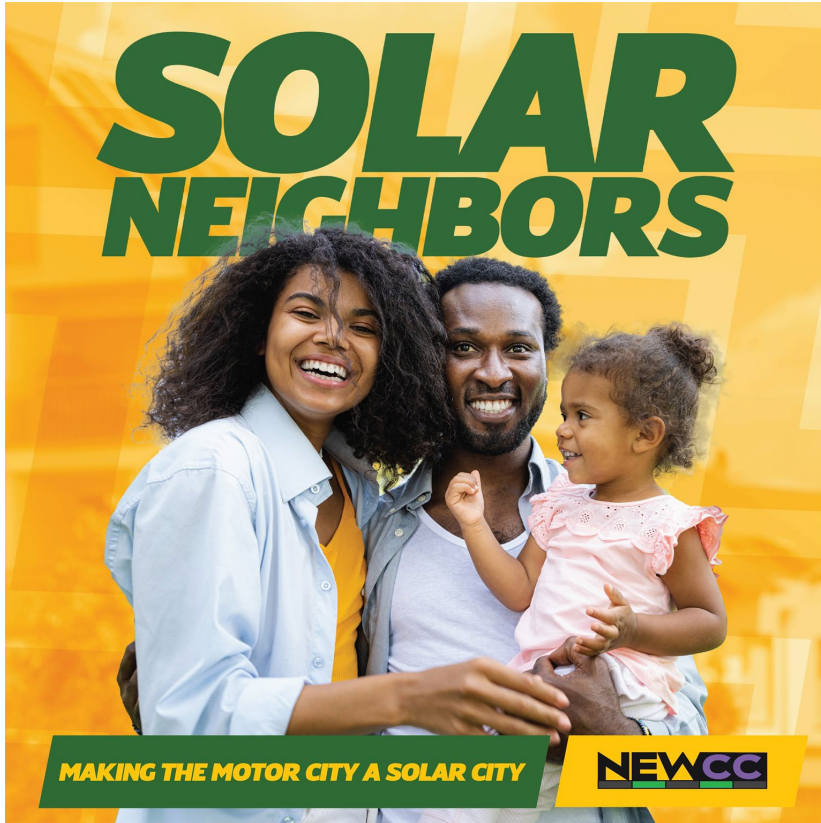


The goal: Develop a 2 MW community solar project that equips 1,000 LMI households in North End Detroit, Hamtramck and Highland Park, Michigan with solar solutions by 2024.



Phase 1: Weatherize homes to optimize energy efficiency

Phase 2: Outfit 50 households with rooftop/ground mounted solar, using a PPA model

Phase 3: Collect RoI into a “Green Fund” that is reinvested to add solar to additional households and build solar+storage network

Phase 4: Work with the City of Highland Park or Hamtramck to implement a publicly owned, municipal Sustainable Energy Utility (SEU)

The Result: households and businesses are powered from local, renewable energy source that is community-owned and operated, leading to increased resilience and significantly greater energy security and democracy.
