Subject: Porta Coeli Agrivoltaic Farm Project For The Energizing Rural Communities Prize

In response to the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) American Made Challenges Energizing Rural Communities Prize Phase 1 which was launched on March 1, 2023; Sunrise Solar & Consulting LLC have formed partnerships with the rural and remote community of Ancones at San German, Puerto Rico (00683-9402) to develop the "Porta Coeli Agrivoltaic Farm" project. This initiative will directly benefit the community of Ancones by building an Agrivoltaic Microgrid, provide workforce training, and entrepreneurship education to replicate the successful Agrivoltaic model at other Ancones and rural and remote communities' farms and available land. The Microgrid will serve as an energy "oasis" for the Ancones residents during an emergency where electronics, batteries and other electrical artifacts could be charged for free. Also, since the farm contains a well, Ancones residents will have access to water during emergencies. Finally, satellite internet will be available to support the Ancones community during emergencies. The agrivoltaic microgrid will also be used for hands-on training and local Puerto Rico Agrivoltaic configuration proof of concept. In addition, a partnership program will be established to provide the Ancones community with the necessary training and education to replicate and expand Agrivoltaics to other rural and remote communities.

The program will provide Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Installation training, Agricultural Education to determine optimal agricultural activities configuration, financial education to create robust business plans and determine business feasibility. All these training and education will be tailored to coexist with micro-grids or utility-scale solar energy generation. Sunrise Solar & Consulting already has established partnerships with the University of Puerto Rico, the Business & Economic Development Center, Non-Profit organizations, and experts in Engineering and Agriculture to develop the "Porta Coeli Agrivoltaic Farm" and the Educational and entrepreneurship program.
