Part of the ability of BDO Zone ratings to drive local bioenergy projects derives from the unique credibility ratings have with investors: all BDO Zone ratings are issued within the framework of the US industry Standards for Biomass Supply Chain Risk (BSCR), developed by Idaho National Laboratory (INL) and Ecostrat with 6-year support from the US Department of Energy and a group of over 65 capital market investors in the bioeconomy who have publicly announced the availability of \$1 billion to be invested in BDO Zones.
