

FTK Energy, a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) of Smith County Public School District and in collaboration with EHV-T&S Consultants, LLC, will act on the school's behalf to engineer, procure and construct a 75MW solar farm on approximately 500 acres on public trust (16th section) land.

Today, the Smith County Board of Education receives less than \$20K annually from hunting licenses for this 500-acre tract of land. A 75MW solar facility could yield approximately \$100K annually. These additional funds could allow the Smith County school system to sustainability improve their educational programs at both the public school and junior college level; provide scholarships, new building construction, and new athletic and music/art programs are just a few examples.

This pilot program is not a singular project, but it can be replicated within other Mississippi county school systems. This pilot program has the potential to build out to produce \$10MM+ annually after-tax spendable income "For The Kids" within the State of Mississippi Public School System.

On May 23, 2023, the Smith County School District submitted a Letter of Commitment in support of our "For The Kids" energy project.
