Project Title: New North Carolina Project Power Moves: Energizing Rural Communities

Short description: Our goal is to create an interactive network of connectors to energy ownership models, including microgrid communities, that serve rural and Justice40 Initiative areas including those in targeted census tracts in Rowan, Davidson, and Mecklenburg counties and create a pathway of opportunity, access, technical assistance, or a network of partners that can help implement clean energy demonstration projects for the residents of these communities who typically do not have access to community ownership models in rural or remote areas. The aim will be to assess each of our four targeted areas, power map the community partners and gauge their ability to participate in our network of connectors, and then ultimately connect households and residents to access the network as we build community ownership models of alternative energy.
