## Challenges

- Cost burden of housing
- Limited reach of existing programs
- Lack of skilled workers

## Scope & Impact

To overcome challenges, the collaboration extends the existing weatherization program with a public navigator to increase access to weatherization and electrification in Grand County through four extensions:

1. Raise the income limit
2. Expand the services offered
3. Include more building types
4. Enhance landlord outreach

To address the shortage of skilled workers, the program will bundle retrofits into contracts to make them more appealing and work with local education programs.

## Equitable Success

All buildings are in disadvantaged tracts, Moab City and Grand County, prioritizing:

- Affordable housing
- Subsidized affordable housing
- Homes occupied by low-income households
- Buildings with community services
- Resilience hubs or disaster shelters
