The Project Team will develop four innovations for improving the quality of life and reducing energy burdens for Grove Hall and communities like it:

- 1. Develop **technical solution packages** conveying clear processes for decarbonizing homes and small businesses
- 2. Compile integrated financing and **funding packages** that outline affordable pathways for decarbonization
- 3. Identify pathways to provide **resident opportunities** for training and employment in the clean energy transition
- 4. Create a **Community Navigator** position to connect residents with resources
