3 Pillars of Decarbonization Support for Multi-Unit Housing

Provide Technical Assistance

Challenge:

- Metering, tax structure prevent participation in energy programs
- Responsibility for upgrades is split between owner and tenant

Solution:

*Equity Emphasis Area

- Provide free/reduced-cost, wholebuilding weatherization and electrification audits
- Partnership: MC Green Bank and Takoma Park provide funds for energy studies

Outreach + In-Unit Retrofits

Challenge:

- Many renters are low income and face high energy burden
- Residents are unfamiliar with electrification

Solution:

- Demonstrate replicability by piloting in-unit electrification in Equity Emphasis Areas
- Partnership: H4H, CHEER & ECC do grassroots outreach; H4H performs in-unit pilot projects

Financial Coaching/Support

Challenge:

 Multi-unit housing owners have limited financial skillsets, planning capacity, and budget reserves to manage building upgrades

Solution:

- Add financial planning and seed funds for identified project needs
- Partnership: DHCA/MC Green Bank provides financial coaching tools;
 Takoma Park funds decarb projects
