

Franklin Cummings Tech's and PowerOptions' Building Efficiency Service Corps

- Pre-screened buildings owned by PowerOptions' client members to be upgraded include: a five-building homeless shelter; a zoo with more than ten buildings; a three-building arts center; an eight-building youth recreation center; and a state-owned event space. All are equity-eligible; more than 50% of a minimum expectation of 10 upgraded building upgrades would be in Boston's EJ communities.
- Franklin Cummings Tech will provide heat pump installation, user training, and maintenance and service repairs as needed. Workers would include HVACR undergraduates who are paid interns learning about heat pumps in their academic curriculum, and all workers would be supervised by a certified HVACR technician.
- PowerOptions will support member buildings with technical assistance, finding incentives and novel financing mechanisms to offset costs.
