Scaling Multifamily Decarbonization in Massachusetts

CHALLENGE

1% of homes are retrofit annually. To meet our climate goals, we must increase this rate of adoption by at least four times and bring homes into carbon alignment. Many of these homes have other deferred maintenance issues which must also be addressed in order for low- and moderate-income families to participate in this transition.

SOLUTION

Our mission is to decarbonize existing multifamily (MF) housing with a particular focus on affordable housing. We leverage retrofit package standardization, industrialized construction, and innovative financing solutions (with an eye towards addressing the split incentive issue) to aggregate demand for zero carbon aligned retrofits in underserved communities.
