Local incentives and \$0 down financing make it affordable to access the benefits of an all-electric home.

A Gas-Free Home is a Healthier Home With the **Healthy Homes Program**, 100 low- to moderate-income households in multifamily residences will have access to affordable building upgrades. There are cash incentives to replace gas appliances with electric induction stoves and heat pump heating and cooling systems specifically designed for cold climate performance. These improvements deliver health and economic benefits to families throughout Denver that need them most.
