

THE POINT CDC: HUNTS POINT COMMUNITY SOLAR

Hunts Point, Bronx, New York

Located in the southern tip of The Bronx with over 15,000 trucks passing through the area daily, the air quality in Hunts Point is one of the worst in the country, resulting in high levels of asthma, lung cancer, and other health issues for local residents.



Community Organization The POINT

THE POINT has a nearly **30-year history** of serving Hunts Point through **environmental justice efforts**, youth leadership education, and arts & cultural programs.



68% of the population is **Hispanic or Latino**

21% of the population is **Black or African-American**

29% of the population **lives below the federal poverty line**

58% of the population is **rent-burdened**

12% of the population is **unemployed**

THE POINT's goal is eventual **community ownership** of the project, ensuring that **benefits are fed into the neighborhood**. We will use this experience to **develop additional community solar projects** to serve Hunts Point in the future.
