**Meaningful Benefits (MB)** 

<u>MB Greater Household Savings</u>: The planned projects will result in affordable, lower cost and accessible energy for residents. We are targeting a reduction of at least 20% in annual electricity bills. We will leverage **Southern Company** and other companies experienced in designing affordable subscription models tailored for LMI residents or those with limited access to traditional energy sources.

<u>MB Workforce Development</u>: PHW 360 will partner with **I4ED** to create a workforce development strategy that facilitates higher paying jobs for workers, thereby enhancing skills, and marketability. **Veaux Solutions** will create partnerships with local workforce development organizations, unions, community colleges and technical schools to recruit trained workers.

<u>LMI Household Access</u>: We are targeting at least 50% of LMI households as subscribers. As the four planned projects include a number of Disadvantaged Communities. **Veaux Solutions** will forge partnerships with financial institutions and organizations such as **NREL**, **Clean Cities**, and nonprofits to assist residents with understanding the financial benefits of clean energy participation. We will leverage best practices for conducting outreach that improves financial literacy and economic empowerment. We will mentor and employ entrepreneurs from the community, which significantly contributes to wealth building and economic growth.
