178.5 kW rooftop solar at Bear Creek Apartments near Texas Tech University with LMI residents benefitting from lower bills, possible resiliency and member ownership.



Partner of SolarTech since 2019 located in downtown Lubbock.



24.675 kW spread over three new homes in Northeast Lubbock as part of Habitat's drive to empower low-income people with home and energy ownership, education and resiliency.



1,191.75 kW rooftop and parking lot solar at Deerfield Village Apartments in West Lubbock with LMI residents saving \$\$, having access to EV charging, possible resiliency and member ownership.



17.85 kW solar carport with EV charging at the First Unitarian Universalist Church south of Texas Tech University to give access to affordable charging for the surrounding community and church members who also are often low income.



Veteran owned and managed solar company with what is believed to be the largest multifamily installation in the nation last year. Partnering with SolarTech on Lubbock projects.



Local woman owned and operated solar business since 2017 with most likely the largest commercial project to date in Lubbock.



Public policy think tank and community advocacy organization that has been involved in environmental justice advocacy since 2020.
