The Positive Energy Coalition's (PEC) scope is to provide disadvantaged Tulsa residents access to our \$50 unlimited electricity service and solar installation education and training through the Positive Energy Training Program. The electricity service will help relieve the energy burden felt disproportionately by certain populations. The training program will provide a means of escaping poverty and building inter-generational wealth by installing solar and batteries in their own communities.

The PEC's near-term goal is to onboard 500 homeowners onto our \$50 unlimited electricity service, enroll 45 individuals in our training program with a job ready for them to enter upon completing the program, reach 30 Tulsa organizations active in the coalition, install solar and batteries on 10 homes, and save homeowners \$6,000 on electricity costs.

We are striving to onboard 1.6 million homeowners onto our \$50 unlimited electricity service.

This will result in over 100,000 high-paying jobs and 16 gigawatts of solar and batteries installed across the United States.
