Pomona Direct-to-Renter Clean Energy Program: Project Phases

- 1. Progress Phase
- Identify a portfolio of clean energy tech (e.g. induction cooktop, plug-in solar) to offer free to low-income renters
- Recruit 8-12 eligible program participants, conduct pre-program survey, and give them free clean energy tech
- 2. Impact Phase
- Collect feedback from participants on their preferred technologies, how they're being used, and their benefits
- Develop a written protocol for a direct-to-renter program based on our experiences that others can replicate
- 3. Post-Impact and Grand Prize
- Share findings and program model with DOE and clean energy tech innovators via webinars and conferences
- If we receive the grand prize, we will expand to offer the direct-to-renter program to all eligible Pomona residents
