

LACI's Clean Energy Partnership (CEP): Scaling Clean Energy Solutions via Startup Pilots

The Los Angeles Cleantech Incubator (LACI) is creating an inclusive green economy for the people of Los Angeles by: working with startups to accelerate clean technologies; transforming markets through partnerships; and enhancing communities through workforce development & pilots.

MVP: Focused on creating a new platform for inviting, selecting, and supporting startups to pilot commercial solutions that meet the goals and targets of CEP while benefiting from LACI's existing startup incubation programs. Corporate and government partners from CEP will do a "reverse pitch," with startups responding to those specific commercial pilot concepts.



In 2021, LACI launched the Clean Energy Partnership (CEP) to accelerate the move to 100% clean energy while ensuring we meet the needs of transportation electrification, building decarbonization, and grid resilience in the Greater Los Angeles region by the time of the 2028 Olympic Games. To better spur innovation, advance equity, and accelerate implementation, CEP developed the 2028 Clean Energy Roadmap, which lays out 3 solutions-oriented pathways, along with recommended policies, pilots, and other initiatives, to achieve targets
