
## **Re-X Solar Panel Reuse Hub**



- Experience: CPSC led the first ever publicly funded solar panel reuse and recycling projects in the state and other solar panel research projects and policy advocacy that includes repair and reuse provisions in California.
- Findings: There is an absence of reuse/recycling management standards for solar panels, leading owners, installers, and government with little guidance and leaning on community reuse to avoid landfilling panels.
- > **Opportunity:** Solar panel repair and re-installation takes place in most communities, and education and coalition building can increase opportunities, especially with direct funding in local solar panel businesses.

## **Objectives of the Solar Reuse Hub**



1) Identify repair/refurbish facilities for solar panels and estimated cost of transportation and processing; 2) Develop an education campaign geared towards homeowners and PV installers;





 Partner with cities/counties and community groups to organize diversion of working panels; and

4) Review current end-of-life management processes and analyze data on solar panels
