Profitable small-scale validated model

In 2023 90 of our upcycled pillows were purchased to furnish three buildings at Microsoft's Campus of the Future. Our product metrics provided supply chain transparency and positively contributed to their environmentally and socially responsible purchasing initiative. We generated a 60-100% profit margin and provided 100+ hrs of local work.
