- Public EV charging infrastructure is lacking in underserved communities



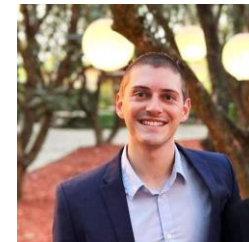
