Project Background

- Southeast (SE) San Diego's Community is engaged, passionate, diverse, family oriented, and hard working. However, SE San Diego residents lack representation in important discussions of energy and sustainability, as well as opportunities to enter the green job economy.
- San Diego Urban Sustainability Coalition (SDUC) exists to bring together communities, stakeholders, and organizations to inform processes and policy through grassroots organizing, improving the quality of life and increasing opportunities for residents of SE San Diego and other resilient communities.
- In the last year, SDUSC has held 18 educational events, during which they reached approximately 230 members of the community. The heart of SDUSC is its ambassador program.

Project Summary

- The ABCDE team will leverage the work SDUSC and its youth ambassador programs have started at Meadowbrook Apartment Complex where the energy burden makes some basic life tasks cost prohibitive. Two examples include laundry and growing food.
