Over the past 17 years, Finger Lakes ReUse (FLR) has developed a local reuse system that provides affordable used goods to the community, diverts materials from landfills, creates job opportunities, and distributes materials to those in need.

This is now a **proven, replicable model** that has been successfully transferred to two additional communities (Cortland and Geneva, NY)

Additionally, FLR is a founding member of Circularity, Reuse, and Zero Waste Development (CROWD). CROWD's cross-disciplinary work to advance circularity and retain embodied carbon within the built environment is a regional solution to a global challenge.

innovates beyond traditional thrift, comprised of a robust online sales component and the brick-and-mortar infrastructure necessary to efficiently market available residential and commercial used materials, processing them by material type and sending them to priority markets utilizing new technologies in the sorting process.

This new approach addresses the true scale of available materials, transforming current material reuse activities happening in silos primarily via direct contractor-to-business trade or in a few reuse outlets that lack the capacity to address locally-produced volumes.
