## The Community

- Located in SE Ann Arbor, MI
- 262-home neighborhood
- One story, single-family homes built circa 1970
- 50% BIPOC
- 50% owned, 50% rented
- 30% of households are energy-burdened



## Engagement Results

- 4 rounds of canvassing
- 88 residents attended 3 project-specific events
- Energy assessments on 80 homes
- 30 resident letters of support
- Countless community events!

## The Project

To achieve whole neighborhood decarbonization, the Team will create a **regional geothermal district** to decarbonize heating and cooling throughout the entire neighborhood. This, stacked with weatherization and solar will lead to a **75% reduction in GHG emissions and cost savings of 77%**.
