Tribal Connections: Advancing Workforce, Renewable Energy, and Independence Solutions

Phase 1 Community Engagement on the Flathead Reservation in Western Montana The Alliance received 410 survey responses (10% of the community members that were engaged) and hosted 143 resident attendees at a Sove IT Solutions workshop and informative energy panel in conjunction with the Tribal Regional Climate Symposium, November 21-22, 2024.

Community Priorities:

- 1. Connect Community Members to Energy Saving Solutions- from Energy Conservation to Solar Generation.
- 2. Solar energy generation that offsets local energy costs and builds energy independence community wide.

Solve IT Solution

- 1. Community Energy Navigator Program. Develop a navigator workforce to complete energy audits and deliver information to residents on weatherization, heat pumps, rebates, and residential solar.
- 2. Increase energy independence and off set energy costs for SKHA residents through a solar and battery project at the Transitional Living Center in Pablo, Montana.

Goal Tracking: Trained Energy Navigators, Completed Residential Energy Audits, Residential Energy Saving Resources Pursued, Residential, Commercial, and Government Solar Projects Planned and/or Completed (aka Solar for All Project Pipeline).
