

Submission – Creating ethical and kind decision making by AI & NL. (August 21, 2018)

Background:

For the last 40 yrs I've been an explorer of solid, breakthrough technologies. In the 1990s, I became acquainted with a breakthrough science named Axiology. ([Wikipedia](#))

By being able to connect two sets of 18 phrases with a well validated mathematical system, the science can accurately assess the decision making of people across 80 different attributes. This is possible because of the 6.4 quadrillion possibilities of ranking the two sets of 80 items.

The science, having originated in academics, has largely been used for education & ethical decision-making training. Commercially, it is largely used to executive coaching, building team excellence and hiring.
